

## **How to Lower Roaming Aggressiveness Using Windows XP**

- 1. Right-click the wireless icon in the system tray (lower right);  
select "Open Network Connections"**
- 2. Right-click your Wireless Network Connection;  
select "Properties"**
- 3. Click the 'Configure' button**
- 4. Go to the Advanced Properties (depending on your driver or  
wireless card, this may be on an "Advanced" tab)**
- 5. In the "Properties" field, select "Roaming Aggressiveness" or  
"Roaming Tendency"**
- 6. In the "Value" area, select the lowest possible setting**
- 7. Click 'OK' to save changes**

**NOTE: If your card does not have this option you may need to update your drivers. Visit the Web site of your computer or wireless card manufacturer for the latest drivers.**
